In the 2012-2013 school year, South Medford High School received an Overall State Rating of four out of five. That means our students are performing as well or better on standards-based tests and graduating in about the same numbers as students at other Oregon high schools. When compared to schools with similar student demographics, South Medford High School is well above average.

Key academic highlights:

- 88.6% met/exceeded state standards for reading
- 78% met/exceeded state standards for math
- Our graduation rate for students who attended South Medford

High School all four years was 80.1 percentage.

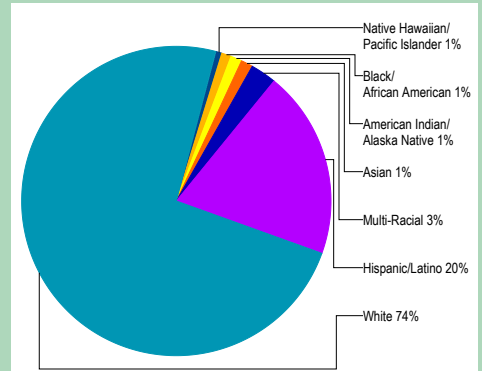

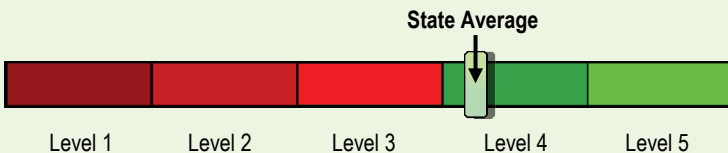


OVERALL STATE RATING

HOW ARE STUDENTS AT THIS SCHOOL PERFORMING COMPARED TO THOSE AT OTHER SCHOOLS?

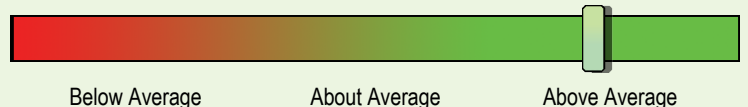
The overall state rating is intended to summarize this school's particular successes and challenges. It is based on a combination of up to five factors. Three of these factors come from standardized test scores in reading and math: student achievement, student growth, and the growth of underserved subgroups. High schools are also rated on the overall graduation rate for the school and the graduation rates of underserved subgroups. Please be aware that this rating is based mainly on high-stakes testing and accordingly, represents a limited view of student performance. Other aspects of this report card are designed to put this rating in the proper context.

Compared to all schools statewide in 2012-13, this school is rated as Level 4.



- Level 1** = Falls into the bottom 5% of schools
- Level 2** = Falls between 5% and 15% of schools
- Level 3** = Falls between 15% and 44% of schools
- Level 4** = Falls between 44% and 90% of schools
- Level 5** = Falls into the top 10% of schools
